# **RESEARCH: Our joint project**

A very wide and ever-increasing variety of special equipment is needed for the disabled to carry out the simple tasks demanded by day-to-day living, whether they live in their own home or in a hospital such as ours.

The scope of such equipment ranges from simple aids like walking frames to complex engineering devices like the remote control Possum typewriter which can be operated by puffing into a mouthpiece.

### **Unique Opportunity**

About 100 of our patients suffer from multiple sclerosis, and the remaining 150 from other, equally disabling, diseases, such as forms of rheumatoid arthritis, Parkinsonism, muscular dystrophy, traumas and Friedreich's Ataxia.

This means that here at Putney—and at our holiday home in Brighton—we have a unique opportunity to specify, to test and to evaluate equipment for the severely disabled.

### Medical Research

A Research Unit, linked with the Institute of Neurology, Queen Square, is being formed for this purpose and the Development Trust for the Young Disabled has set a target of £200,000 to meet the cost.


(The Trust has already raised some £600,000 to finance the Chatsworth Wing and the John Howard House.)



Wren's reconstruction of much of London following the Great Fire remains as testimony to his architectural brilliance.

Today many of his smaller churches are obscured by the burgeoning City skyline. 




